California Proposition 65 Compliance

This document certifies that to the best of our current knowledge and belief and under normal usage, all Zymbit products are in compliance with California Proposition 65. Although some of our products use semiconductors and other electronic components that contain lead internally, there is no risk of exposure, such as contact with food/drink or inhalation. Zymbit products contain No Significant Risk Levels for cancercausing chemicals and are below the Maximum Allowable Dose Levels (MADL) for chemicals causing reproductive toxicity. Therefore, a warning label that our products contain compounds that may cause cancer, birth defects, or reproductive harm is not required
